## Philippines:

Director Campbell Kelley has always had a heart for the Philippines where he has worked at the feeding program in the smoky mountain community in Manila where thousands of children go hungry, hunt for garbage all day to sell for the price of a meal and are without any education. In 2015 Director Kelley led a team back to the Philippines to check up on our progress.

"When we think of poverty, hunger and abuse, we normally think of Africa, where we also provide support, but the fact is that tens of thousands of children are sexually trafficked here in the Philippines alone. And thousands of children live off of one meal a day that might cost around eleven cents. We at ACF are making a difference in these children's lives and I'm proud to be a part of our team."
