Protecting, Rescuing and Caring for Children around the World.



UCAN: The 4-5 day workshop, designed by members of ACF specifically for children who have suffered from physical and sexual abuse, was established in order to provide young children 13-18 with the necessary life tools to enable them to move beyond their past and work towards achieving their goals. The UCAN seminar has achieved great success in four countries where children have shared that it was “greatest thing to ever happen to them.”

In **Cambodia**, over **100,000 children are used for sexual tourism.** ACF helps to rescue and rehabilitate young girls and boys from sex traf-

ficking. We are proud to be working with organizations that are committed to not only rescuing these beautiful children but also providing them with **shelter, food, education and even jobs.**

In **Juarez Mexico**, the country’s most dangerous city, ACF works closely with one of the city’s best orphanages and schools to help provide rescued children with not only food, shelter, clothing and education but with a new **family** — a family dedicated to sharing **God’s love** with the children and providing them with **HOPE.**

In **Afghanistan**, ACF works to rescue children orphaned by the war and taken off of the dangerous city streets into a safe new home and orphanage. Within Kabul we are so excited to be providing these little angels with a priceless and very rare education.

In **Haiti**, where over **200,000 children** are estimated to be enslaved,

we support a feeding project that provides over 8,000 children with daily meals.

In the **Philippines**, where over **100,000 children** are estimated to have been sexually abused and thousands more enslaved, our ACF family is so happy to be a part of helping the act **rescuing** children who have lived in the worst imaginable circumstances and providing them with a safe home. Without their new homes many of their lives would surely have been taken.

In **Uganda**, where a disturbing figure reveals that over 60% of young girls have been sexually abused, we work closely with our amazing partners to minister, rescue, rehabilitate, love and care for the children directly off the streets.

In the **USA**, ACF has partnered with American organizations to provide cutting edge **research and spread awareness** about the problem of child sexual trafficking right here in



the USA. It’s unacceptable that according to studies **over 200,000 US children are in danger of being sexually trafficked.**

In **Guatemala**, ACF was able to deliver over 1,000,000 dollars worth of aid to go towards helping families that were in great need.

In **South Africa**, where babies as young as **9 months old are kidnapped and raped**, ACF conducted two UCAN Seminars for 100 children. These young children who had suffered from sexual and violent abuse shared that the **UCAN** workshop was one of the **best experiences of their lives.**
